Coaches:

- Please fill out the online RACE ENTRY SYSTEM, listing all team athletes by race, by May 25th.
- Please submit the TEAM ENTRY FORM, and submit it to the Green Lake Small Craft Center, along with the team entry fee, no later than Friday, May 25th, 2018.

Race Entries:

The Race Entry System will be open on Mon May 14th at http://www.sckclub.org/sckcreg/TH17.aspx . Access details will be sent out to all coaches the week beforehand.

Each athlete may enter a total of 7 races. Further races are automatically ignored for scoring.

In the Race Entry System unaffiliated entries will be accepted from competitors who are not currently members of a recognized USAC/K or CKC club. For Organization, enter Unaffiliated. However, see eligibility rules below.

Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Director at the Scratch Meeting, absolutely no entries will be accepted after the Scratch Meeting.

Team Entry Fees:

The non-refundable entry fee is **\$60.00 U.S.** funds per athlete. Paracanoe entry is **\$25 U.S.** funds per athlete. Team Entry Form & Fees are due by Friday, May 25th, 2018, 5:00pm. Checks or credit card information payable to City of Seattle. Payments received after the deadline date will owe DOUBLE the amount.

<u>NOTE:</u> All mens K4 races will be run over 500m this year, to better align the regatta with international trends.

Paracanoe races will be 200m on both Saturday and Sunday. The Saturday races are intended primarily for those seeking qualifying times for the US National team. The Sunday races are intended for all paracanoe athletes.

NOTE: Open and Masters races are separate races.

All Masters races will be direct finals. In Masters races with more than 10 boats, Finals will be split into multiple races, and scoring will be based on the best overall times.

NOTE: Age Groups will follow USACK standards:

Bantam: Must be under 14 years old on January 1, 2018 Juvenile: Must be under 16 years old on January 1, 2018 Junior: Must be under 18 years old on January 1, 2018 Master: Must be at least 29 years old on January 1, 2018 AllU18: Includes races for Bantam, Juvenile and Junior

Eligibility:

You must be a current ACA (or CKC) member in good standing in order to race. Each competitor must be:

- a member of ACA by May 25th, 2018, or
- a member of CKC by May 1st, 2018

All competitors must have signed the ACA waiver. All competitors must be competent swimmers. It is the responsibility of the entering organization to verify this.

Scratch Meetings:

The Team Boat Building Virtual Meeting will be held on Saturday, June 2nd, at 1:00 PM. Access details will be sent out closer to the time. Team boats not completed at this meeting will be eliminated.

Directions to Venue:

GREEN LAKE The competition venue is located at the south end of the lake, adjacent to the boathouses. From I-5, exit at NE 50th Street (just north of the UW). Turn west onto NE 50th ("NE" becomes "North"). Follow about 25 blocks to the 5-way intersection at Stone Way. Turn right (north) onto Green Lake Way N. Continue north to just past first light; turn left (west) just before the "Pitch & Putt Golf Course" onto W Green Lake Way N. The venue is on your right, just past the golf course.

Parking:

The semicircular parking lot overlooking the lake and racecourse will be our staging area, as in the past. Travelling northwest along Green Lake Way, this is the second lot on the right (lake side). Boat trailers may park along the left side (when facing northwest) of this lot, parallel to the street and tight to the curb. Please do not park opposite the regatta management area (where the tents are). There are two large lots on the left side of Green Lake Way (opposite from the lake) and another lot on the right (lake side) south of the main regatta parking lot. Additional parking may be available up the paved road in front of the tennis courts by the picnic shelters - only a short walk to the lake. Drop off your equipment before you park.

Security:

Boat security will be available both Friday and Saturday nights from 7:30pm to 5:00am.

Please indicate the number of dinner tickets your team would like on the Team Entry Form. All participants, families, volunteers, coaches, chaperones and supporters are invited. There will be no charge for this dinner.
