



## 2019 PACIFIC CUP/U14 BC PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP REGATTA

**Date** Saturday, September 7 and Sunday, September 8

**Location** Ridge Canoe and Kayak Club (RCKC)  
27871 – 113<sup>th</sup> Ave  
Maple Ridge, BC

**Cost** \$40 CAD per athlete (+ \$15 late entry fee)

Athletes who have not been registered by the August 27 deadline will be assessed a late fee (entry fee + \$15). Late entries will only be permitted if a lane is available

CanoeKayak BC (CKBC) will invoice clubs.

**Registration Deadline:** 11:59 pm on Tuesday, August 27.

A draft draw will be sent out prior to September 4. Coaches will have a set time to make any changes.

A final draw will be available on Friday, September 6.

**Changes to entries during race day:** substitutions and scratches can be made during race day by completing a CKBC Name Change Form and submitting the Form to the Competition Secretary. Additions MAY be accepted if a lane is available.

**Athletes** All competitors must be registered competitive members of a CKBC, CKC or USACK club.

It is expected that Canadian clubs provide a volunteer or official.

- **U11:** K1 1000m; C1 500m;
  - **U12:** K1 1000m; C1 500m; K2/C2 500m; K4/C4 500m;
  - **U13:** K1/C1 1000m;
  - **U14:** K1/C1 1000m; K2/C2 500m; K4/C4 500m;
  - **Novice:** K1/C1 1000m; K2/C2 500m; K4/C4 500m

Race limit: \*\*\* **8 events per athlete** \*\*\*

**Coaches** Coaches and officials will meet 1 hour prior to the start of the races each morning

Key points:

- Athletes competing in ALL races must be uniformly dressed in the approved colours and design of their club
- No false starts
- Athletes are expected to stay in their own water
- 8 events per athlete

**Categories**

**U11:** Born in the year 2008 or later  
**U12:** Born in the year 2007  
**U13:** Born in the year 2006  
**U14:** Born in the year 2005  
**Novice:** U16 athlete (born in 2003 or later) that has NOT competed in a singles events at their respective National Championships

**Technical**

- Clubs are expected to bring their own deck numbers. Numbers for lanes 10 and higher for the 1000m event will be provided.
- Bear/tub/Canadian C-4's will be used (i.e. no IC4's).
- **U16 and younger athletes must wear PFD's approved under the small vessels regulations within Canada's Shipping Act**

**Trailers**

- Trailers may be parked at RCKC on the night of Friday, September 6.

**Other**

- Please note that the Whonnock Lake Beach has been closed this summer for e coli concerns. A communication strategy as to whether there are any modifications to the event will be announced shortly.
