



## 2017 PACIFIC CUP REGATTA

**Date** Saturday, September 9 and Sunday, September 10

**Location** Ridge Canoe and Kayak Club (RCKC)  
27871 – 113<sup>th</sup> Ave  
Maple Ridge, BC

**Cost** \$40 per athlete (+ \$15 late entry fee)

Athletes who have not been registered by the August 31 deadline will be assessed a late fee (entry fee + \$15). Late entries will only be permitted if a lane is available

**Registration Deadline:** 11:59 pm on Thursday, August 31.

Blake will send out a draft draw prior to September 5. Coaches will have a set time to make any changes.

A final draw will be available on Friday, September 8.

**Changes to entries during race day:** substitutions and scratches can be made during race day by completing a CKBC Name Change Form and submitting the Form to the Competition Secretary. Additions MAY be accepted if a lane is available.

**Athletes** All competitors must be registered competitive members of a CKBC, CKC or USACK club.

**Volunteers and Officials** \*\*\* We are always in need of volunteers (especially boat drivers) and officials \*\*\*

It is expected that Canadian clubs provide a volunteer or official.

Boat drivers require a Pleasure Craft Operators Card (or

American equivalent) and should register at the above link.

As per CKBC Travel Policy, Officials that have participated in approved training, upgrading or re-training course within 3 years of the event and be available for over 50 per cent of the regatta are eligible for travel support. Eligible officials must register their availability 48 hours prior to the event.

- **Novice:** K1/C1 200m; K2/C2 200m; K2/C2 500m;
- **Master:** K1/C1 200m; K2/C2 200m; K1/C1 500m; K2/C2 500m;
- **Para:** K1/C1 200m; K1/C1 500m
- **War Canoe**

Race limit: \*\*\* **8 events per athlete (war canoe does not count towards the 8 race limit) \*\*\***

**N.B.** U11/U12 Races: like last year, there will be no finals for U11 races, U12 Singles and Novice crew races.

Ranking will be determined by time from the heats. Same with all fours events.

**Coaches** Coaches and officials will meet 1 hour prior to the start of the races each morning

**Rules** CanoeKayak Canada's Sprint Racing Discipline Competition Rules 2017-2018 ("Rulebook") will be used. See <http://canoe kayak.ca/wp-content/uploads/2014/11/2017-18-EN-Rulebook-Final-1.pdf>

Key points:

- Athletes competing in ALL races must be uniformly

dressed in the approved colours and design of their club

- No false starts
- Athletes are expected to stay in their own water

### **Categories**

U11: Born in the year 2006 or later

U12: Born in the year 2005

U13: Born in the year 2004

U14: Born in the year 2003

U15: Born in the year 2002

Novice: athletes that are under 21 years of age and have not competed at the Canadian or American National Championships

Master: >1981

### **Technical**

- Clubs are expected to bring their own deck numbers.
- Bear/tub/Canadian C-4's will be used (i.e. no IC4's).
- **U15 and younger athletes must wear PFD's approved under the small vessels regulations within Canada's Shipping Act** (see Rule 2.17 of the Rulebook)

### **Trailers**

Trailers may be parked at RCKC on the night of Friday, September 8.
