Bedford Channel – Brae Island day-use area

10am 2km K1, C1, OC1
 Bantam, Novice, and Master divisions
This course paddles down the channel one km, has one turn,
then paddles upriver finishing in front of the docks
1035am - Awards ceremony in staging area

1030am 20km Marathon C2, K1, C1, Surfski, OC1
 Open division
This course starts downstream and, if conditions are favourable, goes
upriver past the airport to West Creek, returns to portage at the
start/finish line - and then repeat the route.
10.05am racers must attend pre-race meeting in staging area for course details
1245pm - Awards ceremony in staging area

1100am 6km K1, K2, C1, C2, OC1, Surfski
 Bantam, Novice, Master divisions
This race uses the 2km course repeated three times
Noon - Awards ceremony in staging area

- *Keep to the right and give space when passing other boats.*
 - *Safety boats and spotters will be located along the race course.*
 - *Each race will be mixed, men and women paddlers.*
 - *The Day-use area of Brae Island Regional Park offers washrooms and change facilities close to the staging area.*
 - *Fort Camping concession will be open for breakfast and lunch at their office building and camping is available.*
 - *The first few boat trailers may park in the staging area – all other vehicles must park on Glover Road.*
